July 5 – Safety

Scripture:

Psalm 23: 1 The Lord is my shepherd. He gives me everything I need. 2 He lets me lie down in fields of green grass. He leads me beside quiet waters. 3 He gives me new strength. He guides me in the right paths for the honour of his name. 4 Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will not be afraid. You are with me. Your shepherd's rod and staff comfort me. 5 You prepare a feast for me right in front of my enemies. You pour oil on my head. My cup runs over. 6 I am sure that your goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life. And I will live in the house of the Lord forever. (NIRV).

Message:

To be safe is to be protected from harm and danger. To feel safe is to know that no hurt or peril will affect you and you are secure from anything that will negatively impact your well-being. Psalm 23 tells of a Shepherd, that looks after and protects His flock. We are a part of the flock of the Lord and like any good Shepherd, He will look after us. To be a part of His special flock we have to give our lives over to Him. The Lord cannot protect the sheep that have wandered away from the flock, wandered away from His care. When we wander away, we take ourselves out of the range of protection, exposing ourselves to anything or anyone that can injure us. Thus to be protected, we must remain within and under the care of the Lord.

In this Covid season, we are being constantly reminded that whatever we do and wherever we go to be 'safe'. We are reminded to constantly wash our hands, keep our hands away from our faces, to wear our masks, to sanitize among many other things. We can be safe too with our Lord when we repent of our sins, put ourselves in His hands, listen and obey His voice and be guided and directed by Him. Listen to the Lord, live for the Lord, be safe with the Lord.
