**Scripture:**

**Luke 8:8 Still other seed fell on good soil. It grew up and produced a crop 100 times more than the farmer planted. (NIRV)**

**Message:**

**To bear good fruits, a tree must be in good condition and the seed which produced the tree must have been a good one in the first place. If the seed was not good, it would have become rotten in the ground. If it was not planted in the right soil and right conditions receiving sunlight and water, it would wither away. But once the seed is good, over time, it would bear some good fruits. If you are a seed of God, then you are a good seed. To be a good seed means listening and obeying the word of God, living a life for Him and being an example to others. Your life will be a testimony of what it means to be a good seed and to bear good fruits.**

**To be a bad seed is to do wrong as well as to encourage others to do the wrong. To be a good seed, you first have to be the right person in the sight of God so that you can lead others in being and doing what is correct. A good seed has high morals and standards, makes the right decisions, seeks the joys of life and is a witness for Jesus Christ. A good seed will always grow into a good tree because he/she was planted in good soil. And of course, the tree will produce good fruits. Be a good seed, planted by Jesus Christ, who will bear good fruits for Him.**
