Scripture:

Luke 8:8 Still other seed fell on good soil. It grew up and produced a crop 100 times more than the farmer planted. (NIRV)

Message:

What kind of seed are you? And if I were to plant you, what kind of fruits would you bear? Whatever seed you plant, it is the same fruit you will get. If you plant a mango seed, you will get a mango tree then it will bear mangoes. You cannot plant a cucumber seed and expect it to bear pumpkins. Just as you plant the seed, you have to water it and take care of it so that it grows and produce fruits. Good seeds will produce good plants and then good fruits. Added to the good seed are the right amounts of water and sunshine.

First you must be a good seed, someone who reads his/her Bible and live the right life, also do and say the right things. But most important, you must hear and obey the word of God. If you have done wrong, then you must ask God to forgive you, let Jesus live in your heart and try very hard not to make the same mistake again. That is being a good seed, when you listen to, obey and live for Jesus. As a good seed, you will bear good fruits. Good things happen to and follow good people.
