Scripture:

Romans 12:9 "Love must be honest and true. Hate what is evil. Hold on to what is good." (NIRV)

Message:

There are three important things to learn from our verse for today. The first is this, when you love somebody, you must truly love them at all times and not some of the time. Nor do you love with a false love, but openly and honestly. A false love is blind and can lead all into trouble, but a true love even points out when the person is wrong or behaving foolishly. The second point is to hate what is wrong and what is evil. Evil does exist and can come in many forms. Recognize evil for what it is and stay away from it. Do not let the evil one tempt you into doing what is wrong.

The third point is to cling to what is right and to hold on to what is good. Cling to Jesus Christ. Not only is He good, He wants what is good for us. He points us in the right direction and guides us into making the right decisions. Learn to tell the difference between good and bad, also between good and evil. Keep away from the bad and from the evil. Instead, seek out and search out good things and good people. Stay close to those who wish you well and who can add meaning to your life. Let your love be true and when you give true love, it comes back to you.
